BAD BODY TEXT

More helpful hints

Remember:

- Simple, effective data display
- Small blocks of supporting text, images and graphs say much more than words
- Avoid resolution problems with your images (at least 150 dpi, but no more than 300 dpi)
- Be aware of busy backgrounds

- Can you read the type?
- Does it look too busy?
- Do my main points pop out?
